Thank you for your interest in membership on the Sudbury Council on Aging (COA) Board of Directors.

The Sudbury Senior Center is dedicated to serving the social, recreational, health and educational needs of older adults in the community. The Board is the policy-making body that determines the overall direction of the Senior Center and its services for seniors, and guides the Senior Center Director.

The duties of the Board are to:


- 1. Identify the total needs of the community's elderly population;
- 2. Educate the community and enlist the support and participation of all citizens concerning these needs;
- 3. Design, promote, or implement services to fill these needs, or coordinate present existing services in the community;
- 4. Promote and support any other programs which are designed to assist the elderly in the community.

To serve on the Board, an individual must be an adult resident of Sudbury.

In general, the Board meets on the first Tuesday of each month at 3:00 PM in the Senior Center. Board members assist with projects developed by the Senior Center, volunteer time at various events (depending on availability), and may serve on one or more of the subcommittees of the Board.

Appointments are made by the Board of Selectmen upon the recommendation of the COA Board, for a three-year term. An individual may be reappointed to one additional three year term. Terms begin with the June meeting.

All applications are reviewed by the Membership Committee of the Board. This committee, along with the Director, conducts interviews of the applicants and makes recommendations for appointment to the Board.
