The Sudbury Senior Center supports people aged 60 and older and their families through:

- **Advocacy:** We work for legislation to lighten the property tax burden for seniors, and provide supports for independence.
- **Programs:** We offer a wide range of programs to entertain, educate, foster healthy aging, and promote creativity.
- **Information and Resources:** We keep up-to-date on the latest services for seniors, and provide individualized consultations for seniors and their families.
- **Community service:** Through our volunteer programs like FISH and Friendly Visitors, we offer seniors a chance to both give and receive service at no cost.

Many of our services are provided **free of cost**. Some request a donation. For those which require a fee, scholarships are often available. There is no membership fee for using the Senior Center.



At the center we offer lifelong learning, exercise classes, health and wellness information, nutrition information and meals, computer assistance, travel, recreational activities and much more.

In your home we offer home delivered meals, handyman services, transportation in town and to the doctor, medical equipment loans, and more!

Who can take part?

Center programs are primarily for people 60 and older, but we also serve younger people and people with disabilities.

People from other towns are welcome to take part, although Sudbury residents are offered the first chance to enroll.
