This door-to-door, handicapped accessible service is available: Mondays: 8:30 AM-4:00PM Tuesdays: 7:00 AM- 4:00 PM* Wednesdays: 8:30AM- 4:00 PM* Thursdays: 8:30AM-4:00 PM* Fridays: 8:30 AM- 4:00 PM

Riders register and set up a debit account with the MetroWest Regional Transit Authority (MWRTA). Call the MWRTA at 508-820-4650 for an application and reservations. You must call at least 48 business hours in advance to schedule your ride. The van travels within Sudbury and to some destinations close to Sudbury's borders. The cost for in-town trips is \$1.00 each way, and \$2.00 each way for out-of-town rides.

*A pilot program providing extended hours service is available through the MWRTA Call Center. These rides are wheelchair accessible and provided by Kiessling Transportation.
