How it Works

Sudbury residents who wish to have a bucket of sand delivered to them may request it by calling the Senior Center (978-443-3055) and speaking to the receptionist. You will be asked for your name, address, phone number, and for very specific instructions about where you want the filled sand bucket left. Be sure to plan ahead. This is NOT a same-day program.

The Coordinator of Volunteer Programs will relay all this information to a member of the Sand Bucket Brigade, who will deliver the buckets.

If this is a refill request, clients are told to leave the empty bucket in the exact spot you want the filled replacement sand bucket placed.

The program runs through the winter months, starting in the Fall.



Who is the Sand Bucket Brigade?

The Brigade is a group of volunteers whose purpose is to help keep our neighbors safe in inclement weather when walkways and driveways can be slick.
